ANNEXURE-A

COMPARATIVE STATEMENT OF PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE JHARKHAND STATE CRICKET ASSOCIATION, TO BRING THE SAME INTO CONFORMITY WITH THE JUDGMENT OF THE HON'BLE SUPREME COURT OF INDIA DATED 14.09.2022 IN IA NO. 49930 OF 2020 IN CIVIL APPEAL NO. 4235 OF 2014, (2022) 19 SCC

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(Annexed to and forming part of the Notice of Special General Meeting dated 19th August, 2026, in accordance with Rule 40 of the Rules and Regulations of the Association)

The Hon'ble Supreme Court vide its judgment dated 14.09.2022 was pleased to approve and accept amendments to Clauses 6(4), 6(5), 3(b)(vii), 7(3), 14.3, 14.4, 15(3), 15(4) and 19(2) of the BCCI Constitution, and directed that the compliance and registration obligations under paragraphs 45.2 and 45.3 of the judgment dated 09.08.2018 shall apply equally to these amendments. This Comparative Statement sets out, clause-wise, the corresponding position under the Rules and Regulations of the Association, and the amendments now proposed for adoption by the General Body.

A. RULE 8 (TERM OF OFFICE) -corresponding to BCCI Clauses 6(4) and 3(b)(vii)

Existing Rule 8 (relevant extract)	Proposed Amended Rule 8
"Any office bearer or member of the Committee of Management who has held any post for two consecutive terms either in the Association or in the BCCI (or a combination of both) shall not be eligible to contest any further election without completing a cooling off period of three years. During the cooling off, such an office bearer shall not be member of any committee/sub-committee whatsoever of the BCCI or of the Association..."	"8.1 An office-bearer who has held any post for two consecutive terms in the Association shall not be eligible to contest any further election in the Association without completing a cooling-off period of three years. During this cooling-off period, such an office-bearer shall not be a member of the Governing Council or of any committee whatsoever of the Association. 8.2 If a person has served two consecutive terms each, in the Association and in the BCCI (or vice versa) continuously without any break, such person shall not be eligible to contest any further election in the Association or in the BCCI, without completing a cooling-off period of three years. During this cooling-off period, such office-bearer shall not be a member of the Governing Council or of any committee whatsoever of the BCCI or of the Association."

Note: This amendment gives effect, at the level of the Association, to the amended Clause 6(4) and the corresponding State-Association clause 3(b)(vii)(A)/(B) of the BCCI Constitution as approved in 2022.



B. RULE 9 (DISQUALIFICATIONS)- corresponding to BCCI Clause 6(5)

Existing Rule 9	Proposed Amended Rule 9
9(d) is a Minister or Government Servant or holds a public office except for the nominee under Rule 7(j);	9(d) is a Minister or Government Servant, except for the nominee under Rule 7(j);
9(e) holds any office or post in a sports or athletic association or federation apart from cricket;	9(e) [Deleted]
9(f) has been an Office Bearer of the association for a cumulative period of 9 years; or	9(f) has been an Office Bearer of the Association for a cumulative period of 9 years; or (unchanged)
9(g) has been charged by a Court of Law for having committed any criminal offence, i.e. an order framing charges has been passed by a court of law having competent jurisdiction.	9(g) has been convicted by a Court of Law for commission of a criminal offence and sentenced to imprisonment.

(Rule 9(a), (b), (c), and Rules 9A, 9B and 9C remain unchanged.)

C. RULE 13 (POWERS & FUNCTIONS OF OFFICE-BEARERS -HONORARY SECRETARY) - corresponding to BCCI Clause 7(3)

Existing Rule 13(c) (relevant extract)	Proposed Amendment to Rule 13(c)
The Honorary Secretary shall, subject to the general control and direction of the Committee: (i) Be in charge of all minutes, correspondence, records and documents...; (ii) Exercise general supervision, conduct all affairs of the Association according to the Rules but shall not deal with any matter involving any question of policy, Constitution or expenditure of the Association without the prior approval of the Committee; ... [xv sub-clauses in total].	Insert new sub-clauses after Rule 13(c)(xv): “(xvi) Have the power to delegate any work to the Honorary Joint Secretary or any person in management. (xvii) Exercise all powers in relation to cricketing and non-cricketing matters with the respective management personnel, including the Chief Executive Officer reporting to him on a regular basis. (xviii) The management personnel, the staff and the Chief Executive Officer shall work under the direct supervision, control and direction of the Honorary Secretary.”

Note: This amendment concerns the enhanced delegation and supervisory powers conferred on the Secretary under amended Clause 7(3) of the BCCI Constitution.

D. RULES 12 AND 14 (POWERS OF THE COMMITTEE OF MANAGEMENT / CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER) - corresponding to BCCI Clauses 15(3), 15(4)(d), 15(4)(n) and 19(2)

Existing provision	Proposed Amendment
Rule 12(q): “To institute or defend any action or proceedings for or against the Association or against any Office-Bearer or employee of the association.”	Rule 12(q) (amended): “To institute or defend, through the Honorary Secretary, any action or proceedings for or against the Association or against any Office-Bearer or employee of the Association.”

Existing provision	Proposed Amendment
Rule 12(p): "To appoint Managers/officials, clerks and other staff and fix their salaries, allowances, bonus, privileges etc. and to take disciplinary action against them or to dispense with their services."	Rule 12(p) (amended): "To appoint, in consultation with the Chief Executive Officer, Managers/officials, clerks and other staff and fix their salaries, allowances, bonus, privileges etc. and to take disciplinary action against them or to dispense with their services."
Rule 14(i): "The day-to-day management of the affairs of the Association including operations, technical, human resources and finance shall be conducted by a full time CEO in consultation with the Honorary Secretary under the supervision of the Committee of Management..."	Rule 14(i) (amended): "The day-to-day management of the affairs of the Association including operations, technical, human resources and finance shall be conducted by a full time CEO in consultation with the Honorary Secretary, under the supervision of the Committee of Management and under the direct supervision, direction and control of the respective Office-Bearers..."

Note: These amendments concern amended Clauses 15(3) (superintendence over CEO exercised through the Secretary), 15(4)(d) (litigation routed through the Secretary), 15(4)(n) (CEO consultation on staff rules), and 19(2) (day to day management under the supervision of the respective office-bearers) of the BCCI Constitution.

E. NOTE ON BCCI CLAUSES 14.3 AND 14.4 (APEX COUNCIL / COUNCILLORS)

It is clarified for completeness and transparency, that Clauses 14.3 and 14.4 of the BCCI Constitution govern the disqualification and cooling-off of 'Councillors' of the BCCI Apex Council which is a distinct governance tier that exists only at the level of the BCCI. The Rules and Regulations of the Association do not provide for, and the Association does not maintain, a separate 'Apex Council' or the office of 'Councillor'; the functions of governance and management of the Association vest in the Committee of Management under Rule 7. Accordingly, no separate corresponding amendment is required to be made to the Rules and Regulations of the Association in respect of Clauses 14.3 and 14.4, the substance thereof being already addressed, at the level of the Association, by the amendments to Rules 8 and 9 set out above.

This Comparative Statement is issued along with, and forms part of, the Notice convening the Special General Meeting of the Association, in compliance with Rule 40 of the Rules and Regulations of the Association and is further available for inspection at the office of the Honorary Secretary and on the website of the Association.
